

## Successful 2008 K-12 General Obligation Bond Measures

The amount raised by G.O. bonds passed in 2008 alone accounts for 36% of the total raised by G.O. bonds in the last decade.

Despite an extraordinarily dismal economic picture, voters in more than 100 school districts were generous at the ballot with their local schools. Below is a list of successful 2008 K–12 bond measures,

based on the best available information. Altogether, 116 out of 136 (85.3%) of bonds that required 55% voter approval passed in 2008. They raised \$20.6 billion. In addition, three out of four bonds that required a two-thirds vote passed in 2008, raising \$300 million. From 1998 through 2008, local bond elections generated a total of about \$57.4 billion.
