#### 2020 bond:

\$3 billion for Community Colleges

\$10 billion for preschool-12<sup>th</sup> grade



## AB 48: 2020/22 SCHOOL BONDS

#### New & Improved Programs:

- Small district assistance
- Financial Hardship qualifying criteria updated
- Preschool facilities on school sites
- Replacement of 75-year-old buildings
- Minimum Essential Facilities supplemental grant
- Joint-Use criteria updated
- Testing & remediation of lead in drinking water

#### Continuing programs:

- Career Technical Education
- Charter schools
